Sunday Reflection

The Feast of the Holy Trinity invites us to reflect on the profound mystery of God as three persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—united in one divine nature. This truth isn't just theological jargon; it shapes how we understand God's nature, our relationship with Him, and our place in the world.

At its heart, the Trinity reveals that God is relationship. The Father loves the Son, the Son loves the Father, and the Spirit is the bond of that love. God is perfect community, perfect love, and perfect unity. This challenges the common idea of God as a distant, solitary ruler and instead shows us a God who is inherently loving and relational. Because God exists in eternal relationship, we are made in His image to live in loving relationship with Him and with each other.

This mystery also teaches us about the different roles God plays in our lives. The Father is the creator who initiates and plans, the Son is the redeemer who enters human history and restores what was broken, and the Spirit is the sustainer who lives within us, empowering and guiding. Recognizing these roles helps us see God's work in the world and in our personal stories—not as isolated events, but as a continuous, loving engagement.

For everyday life, the Trinity encourages us to live in community and love sacrificially. Just as the three persons of the Trinity are distinct yet unified, we are called to maintain our unique individuality while living in harmony with others. It reminds us that love isn't

just a feeling but a commitment to others, reflecting God's own love.

Finally, understanding the Trinity gives us confidence that God is with us in every part of our journey: creating, saving, and empowering. We are invited to respond by deepening our rela-



tionship with each person of the Trinity through prayer, worship, and acts of love. This feast is not just a celebration of doctrine but an invitation to live into the reality of God's triune life—full of love, connection, and purpose.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

The Most Holy Trinity Year C

First Reading - Proverbs 8:22-31 ~ The Wisdom of God cries aloud: The Lord created me when his purpose first unfolded, before the oldest of his works. From everlasting I was firmly set, from the beginning, before earth came into being. The deep was not, when I was born, there were no springs to gush with water. Before the mountains were settled, before the hills, I came to birth; before he made the earth, the countryside, or the first grains of the world's dust. When he fixed the heavens firm, I was there, when he drew a ring on the surface of the deep, when he thickened the clouds above, when he fixed fast the springs of the deep, when he assigned the sea its boundaries — and the waters will not invade the shore — when he laid down the foundations of the earth, I was by his side, a master craftsman, delighting him day after day, ever at play in his presence, at play everywhere in his world, delighting to be with the sons of men.

Responsorial Psalm - Ps 8:4-9. R. v.2

(R) O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth!

Second Reading - Romans 5:1-5 ~ Through our Lord Jesus Christ, by faith we are judged righteous and at peace with God, since it is by faith and through Jesus that we have entered this state of grace in which we can boast about looking forward to God's glory. But that is not all we can boast about; we can boast about our sufferings. These sufferings bring patience, as we know, and patience brings perseverance, and perseverance brings hope, and this hope is not deceptive, because the love of God has been poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit which has been given us.

Gospel Acclamation ~ Alleluia, alleluia! Glory to the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit: to God who is, who was, and who is to come. Alleluia!

Gospel – John 16:12-15 ~ 'Jesus said to his disciples: 'I still have many things to say to you but they would be too much for you now. But when the Spirit of truth comes he will lead you to the complete truth, since he will not be speaking as from himself but will say only what he has learnt; and he will tell you of the things to come. He will glorify me, since all he tells you will be taken from what is mine. Everything the Father has is mine; that is why I said: All he tells you will be taken from what is mine.'

WHY WE DO THE THINGS WE DO?

Why do we celebrate Trinity Sunday?

God is love. That is the simple, profound truth at the heart of Trinity Sunday. Consider a husband and wife who have loved each other for many years. They approach life with a sense of 'we' rather than 'l'. Paradoxically, instead of losing a sense of self-identity, each spouse discovers a greater sense of uniqueness through the love of the other. This analogy helps us to glimpse the unity of the three persons of the Trinity. God is persons in a relationship of perfect unity; unique persons, but completely one. In a society full of isolated individuals crying out 'Who am I?' on a restless search for self-identity, the feast of the Trinity calls us to ask another question: Whose am I? To whom do I belong? Through relationships of love, we discover God.
